Dear Students, Parents and Carers

June 2025

Firstly, we would like to wish our Year 12 students every success in their coming assessment week. It is a very significant first step towards their A level examinations next summer.

On **Tuesday 24th June**, we will be holding an induction day for our current Year 11 students to allow them to experience A level study for a day. This is important preparation for September and will help to ensure that they have made effective and appropriate subject choices.

We are asking that our current Year 12 students work from home on **Tuesday 24th June** and prepare for their assessments to allow us to accommodate this induction event comfortably.

There are some groups of students within our current Year 12 who will be affected slightly differently by this, and we have outlined instructions below to make our expectations absolutely clear to all. It is important to note that the Common Room will be unavailable for current Year 12 students on this day.

Students who study Physics or PE A level and therefore have assessments in the morning of Tuesday 24th June (also a small number of students with catch-up exams due to clashes).

These students will need to attend school for their scheduled assessment but should not use the Sixth Form Common Room. They should sign in using the i-pad in the New Foyer but do not need to register in their form rooms in the morning.

Students should then sign out after they have completed their assessment. If they do need to wait in school for transport home, they should use the Silent Study Room or S14 and not the common room.

Students who study French or History. These students have assessments in the afternoon of Tuesday 24th June.

These students will need to attend school for their scheduled assessments but should not use the Sixth Form Common Room. They should sign in using the i-pad in the New Foyer. If they arrive early for their assessments, they can go to the Silent Study Room or S14.

In between the morning and afternoon assessments, students may use the Silent Study Room or S14 for quiet study. Students may leave the school site for lunch as usual or use the school canteen.

Students should sign out after completing their assessments and leave the school site to go home. If they do need to wait in school for transport home, they should wait in the Silent Study Room or S14.
