Dear Parents and Guardians,

We would like to inform you that Lincolnshire Road Safety will be visiting school on Wednesday 21st January during Period 4 to give an important talk on road safety and the 'Fatal 5' - speed, drink and drugs, carelessness, distraction, and not wearing a seatbelt. This is a new presentation that Lincolnshire Road Safety have not delivered at our school before, offering up-to-date guidance and information. These presentations often include stark and realistic examples to ensure students fully understand the seriousness of road safety.

Due to unavoidable scheduling conflicts, the talk has been moved out of a Guidance session and therefore is taking place during a students' independent study afternoon, and all Year 13 students will be expected to remain in school.
