I am writing early in the new school year to tell you about some important dates for Year 12 that I hope will be of interest. PSHE Details

Guidance lessons in KS5 centre around the transition into the 6th Form. We then spend a great deal of time focusing on informing students about their Post 18 Options. We take students through the process of applying to Higher Education institutions, which the vast majority of our students wish to do, and also work with students who wish to pursue alternatives on a one to one basis. We also consider aspects of health, safety, employability, positive mental health and beginning to drive which will be factors affecting all of our students. They also have external speakers on topics such as Breast Cancer Awareness, HIV, road safety etc.

Our curriculum at KGGS includes:

- The *Formal Curriculum* - a three-year KS3; two-year KS4; and two-year KS5, featuring a wide range of subjects and courses taught in lessons.
- The *Wider Curriculum* - including extra-curricular activities and clubs; out-of-lesson learning and support; educational visits; wider reading initiatives; competitions and challenges; sports fixtures; charity work; assemblies; and thoughts for the day.
- Enrichment (KS5)
